**Re: Hauling truck traffic in Hudson's Hope**

Dear Hudson's Hope resident,

We're writing to provide an update on the construction of the shoreline protection berm in Hudson's Hope. The berm – a large barrier made of riprap, rocks and gravel – will reinforce the shoreline and protect it from potential erosion once the Site C reservoir is filled.

**Hauling begins this week**

This week, we are starting to haul riprap (large rocks and boulders) from Portage Mountain Quarry to a stockpile area on Clark Avenue. Hauling will continue until the berm is completed in 2022.

**Traffic impacts**

- There will be 2 - 4 return truck trips an hour to begin with. Hauling could eventually increase to 6 – 8 return trips hourly.
- The truck route will be along Canyon Drive and Clark Avenue.
- Hauling will occur between 7 am – 7 pm, seven days a week.
